### Divine Savior News

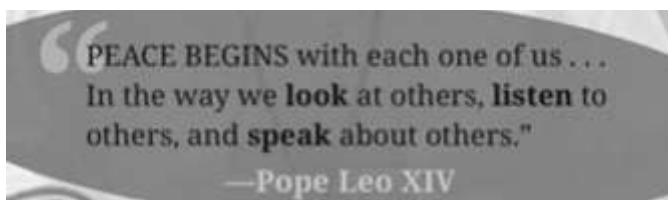

### Parish Fiscal Year Ending

We budgeted \$303,000 for stewardship this fiscal year, a decrease of 2% from last year and 4.5 % from the year before. Right now we're at \$247,966.

In order to reach our budgeted goal we will need \$55,033 by the end of June, or \$11,006 each of the next 5 weeks. In June of 2019, almost \$68,000 came in the office for stewardship. It can happen!

Thank you to everyone who has made stewardship contributions to our parish. Any contributions made after June 30 will be applied to the 2025--2026 **parish fiscal** year. If you have any questions about your contributions to date, contact the office.

or once a year. As we live our lives and challenges arise, we gratefully acknowledge your support to our parish.
