

Signing up on FORMED has become a lot easier and parish codes and custom registration urls are no longer needed. Now parishioners just go to <a href="formed.org/signup">formed.org/signup</a> and find their parish to sign up for the first time.

- 1. Go to formed.org/signup
- 2. Select your parish by entering name, city or zip code
- 3. Enter your name and email address
- Check that email account for a link to begin using FORMED.

Passwords are no longer needed. After you have initially "signed up" and created your account, simply "sign in" to formed.org by entering your email. You will then need to check your email on the same device for an authentication email. Going forward, as long as you don't log out or clear your cookies, you will remain signed in.

Our improved search function will help you discover the content you are looking for, making it easier to find our programs, movies, e-books, and audios. Just click "SEARCH" from the menu bar and then type a title, a subject or a speaker/author you're looking for.






