Three Parishes Religious Education

We are two months into our Religious Ed year and I think things are beginning to settle down. It did as it always does take families some time to adjust to the changes. Due to a shortage of willing volunteers, we have had to make some modifications to the original plan and the program continues to evolve as needed. The teachers have become very good at ***“going with the flow”***. The current volunteers at all three parishes have been amazing and extremely helpful to me along with the ladies that directed each of these programs before me.

St. Ann has 15 students enrolled and classes meet on Monday evenings. This building uses a curriculum made for combined grades. K and 1st are combined along with 3rd – 5th and 6th – 8th. Due to 2nd grade Sacrament Prep these five students are not joined by other grades.

Holy Rosary continues with the Wednesday evening program. With the joining of programs and majority of families preferring Wednesday evening classes the HR building is full and busy with 114 total students. It is really nice to see 8 – 12 students in a class rather than 4 – 6 same grade students in two separate buildings. Grade 5K/1st through 6th have 8 – 12 students per grade. The 7th – 11th grade classes consist of 12 – 17 students per grade with 9th and 10th each at 17 total students.


SSPP has the Sunday Family Program where the parents attend sessions with the children. The program currently consists of five families with a total of 15 children, with an additional HR family possibly joining our next class. The Family Program involves discussion/ teaching geared toward the children followed by an activity that the parents complete with the children. Topics are related to the days Gospel or upcoming Feast Days. Class is followed up by weekly lessons completed at home.

The Confirmation class has 14 students with nine from SSPP, four from HR and

one from St. Ann. The class initially held its first three classes at HR but following **this week's session the Confirmation** classes will be moving to SSPP. The SSPP Parish Center is better equipped for the meals as the kitchen is just a regular kitchen and I am afraid of those big gas stove/ovens at HR. Also, the building has three nice small rooms on the first floor for breakout sessions. The HR building was simply too full to accommodate these plans and I believe **that's a good thing**.

Lastly, we have approximately five students doing structured independent learning. Parents expecting Confirmation for their children in the Green Bay Diocese **can no longer “homeschool” their children**. The children must be studying the curriculum used at the Parish or approved by the parish. Assignments must be turned in weekly and communication between parents and DRE is crucial. Starting next year students wishing to be Confirmed through the Parish can no longer do Ind learning after 6th grade unless there is a valid medical or other reason that the child is unable to attend in person classes.

We do still need a k5/1st grade teacher and in January we will need a 3rd Grade teacher. We are also looking for door monitors. All RE volunteers must complete the Diocese Virtus training and complete a Background check. If you are interested in volunteering, please contact Lisa Gross drethreeparishes@gmail.com.
