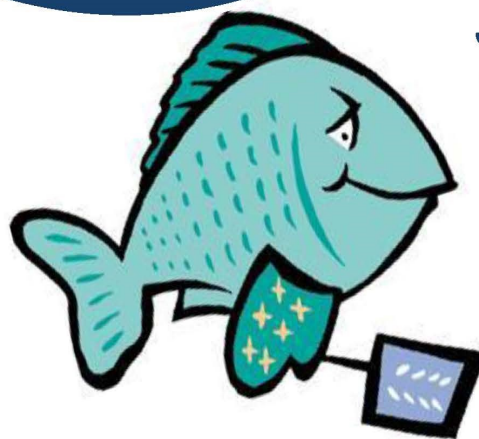

Welcome Dcn Mark Rydell

Dcn Mark Rydell, who is a seminarian of the Green Bay Diocese in the last year of seminary formation, has been assigned to our parish for his weekend diaconal assignment beginning this first Sunday of Lent. Dcn Mark is a transitional Deacon (which is different from a permanent Deacon) because he is in formation for the Priesthood. God willing, his priestly ordination will take place in the Spring this year. His seminary formation takes place at St. Francis de Sales Seminary in Milwaukee. As he is not done with seminary classes yet, he can only be with us 2 or 3 weekends each month beginning from the first weekend of Lent, February 17/18, 2024. He will also assist with the Holy week liturgies. Lent

Lent is a time of preparation for Easter. We reflect on the suffering and death of Christ, we fast and abstain, and we pray, in order that our hearts might be more ready for the covenant that God has for us.



This Lent try to dive deeply. Allow this to be a time of purification and penance so that when Easter time comes, you will truly know what it means to rejoice. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may only eat one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
