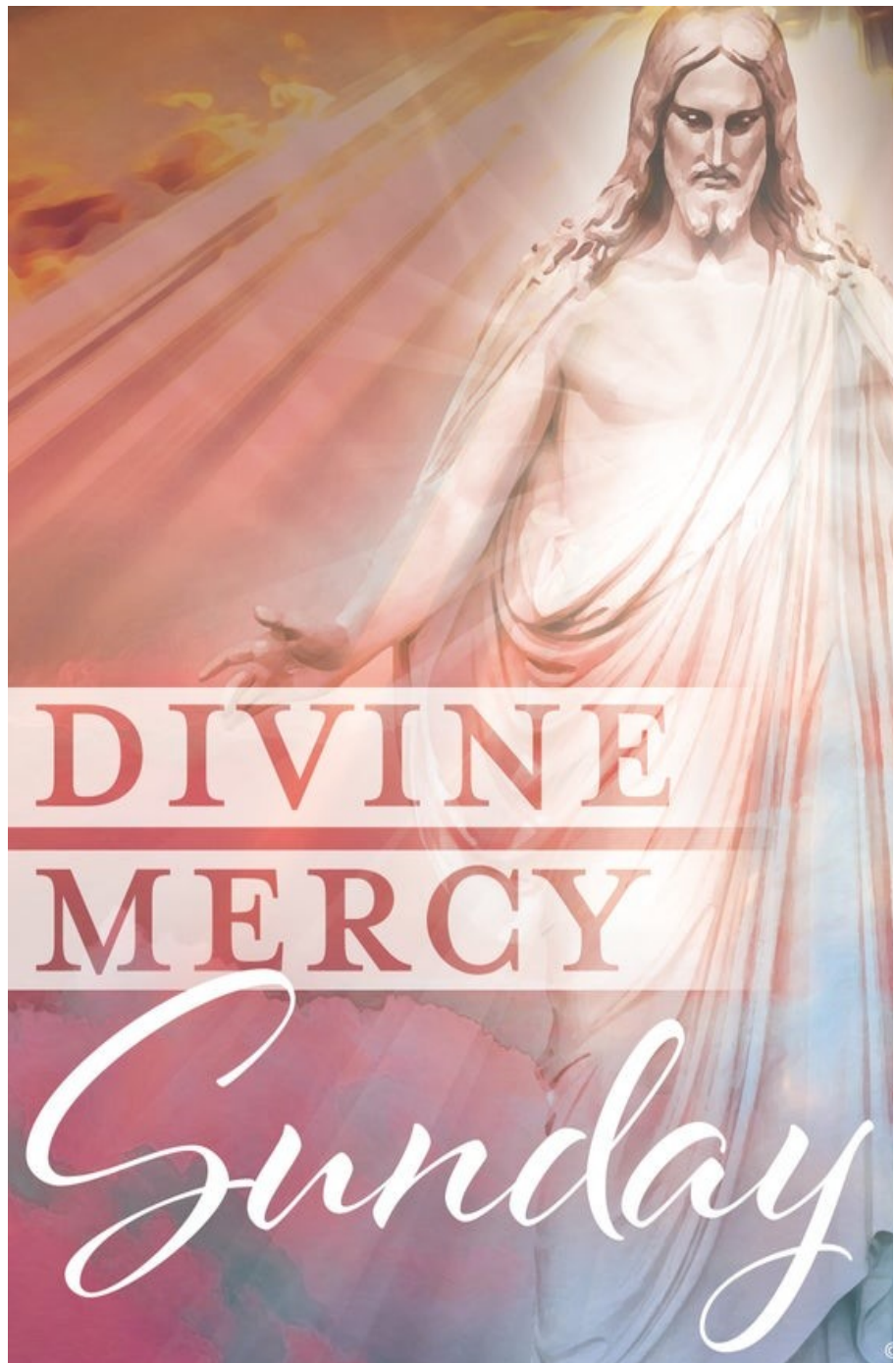

Sunday of Divine Mercy

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Divine Mercy Sunday to all of you! I pray that you and yours may continue to glow and rejoice in the joy of the risen Lord “whose mercy endures forever” (Ps 136). The Second Sunday of Easter is celebrated as Divine Mercy Sunday. I know that many of you are familiar with the Divine Mercy Novena, the Divine Mercy Chaplet and the mystical revelations given by Jesus to Sr. Faustina Kowalska (1905 - 1938), a Polish Nun through whom Jesus revealed this beautiful devotion as an avenue to immerse oneself and all sinners in the ocean of God’s mercy. Through a number of powerful mystical experiences and revelations received in prayer, Jesus commissioned Sister Faustina (as she was then known) to write and teach people about his unfathomable divine mercy. Sr. Faustina wrote about these mystical revelations in a book published after her death. She was canonized a saint in the year 2000. The book is called “The Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska.” I highly recommend this book to anyone who wishes to pray better and to grow in their faith. The Divine Mercy Chaplet remains for me a beloved and treasured way to pray.

In a section titled “My Preparation for Holy Communion,” St. Faustina writes; “The most solemn moment of my life is the moment when I receive Holy Communion. I long for each Holy Communion, and for every Holy Communion I give thanks to the Most Holy Trinity. If the angels were capable of envy, they would envy us for two things: one is the receiving of Holy Communion and the other is suffering” (Diary, no. 1804). She continues, “I go out to meet Him, and I invite Him to the dwelling place of my heart, humbling myself profoundly before His majesty. But

the Lord lifts me up from the dust and invites me, as His bride, to sit next to Him and to tell Him everything that is on my heart. And I, set at ease by His kindness, lean my head on His breast and tell Him of everything. In the first place, I tell Him things I would never tell to any creature. And then, I speak about the needs of the Church, about the souls of poor sinners, and about how much they have need of His mercy. But the time passes quickly. Jesus, I must go to carry out the duties that are awaiting me” (Diary, no. 1806).

During this year of Eucharistic Revival, we can all learn and grow in Eucharistic faith from the example and writings of holy men and women like St. Faustina Kowalska. May we trust ever more completely in the mercy of the Lord, praying with humble faith, “Jesus I trust in you.”

Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place all our hope in you!

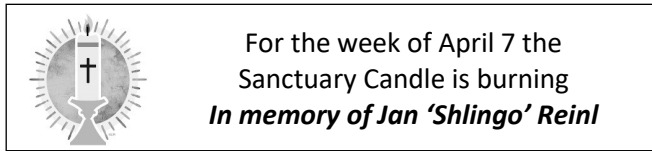

Fish Fry Thank You

Sometimes saying thank you doesn't seem like enough. So we're shouting it out loud! Thank you to those who supported our fish fry in ANY way. Donating food, supplies & cash, helping with food prep, making a torte (or 5!), buying a fish fry (or 5!), and working a shift or two. The willingness of our parishioners to help in so many ways is such a blessing to this faith community. We served 228 fish plates during the lunch hour, we delivered another 308 to area businesses at lunch, and another 468 were served at night, for a total of 1,004. We were planning for 900, so we did run out of a few things, but not fish. We fried every piece of fish we had to fill all the orders. We made about \$9,600 profit, and that helped us pay the school subsidy in March.

I want to shout thank you to our fish fry committee. They worked tirelessly behind the scenes the weeks before and that day to make sure we were able to serve a great meal. Their willingness to go above and beyond speaks volumes to their commitment to our event. I am grateful to have them on our team.

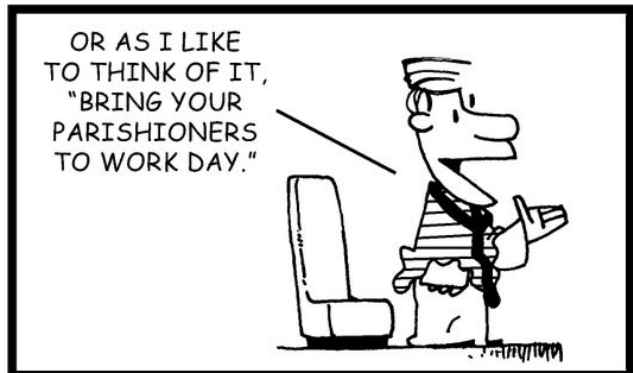
St. Ann Spring Cash Raffle

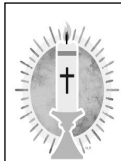

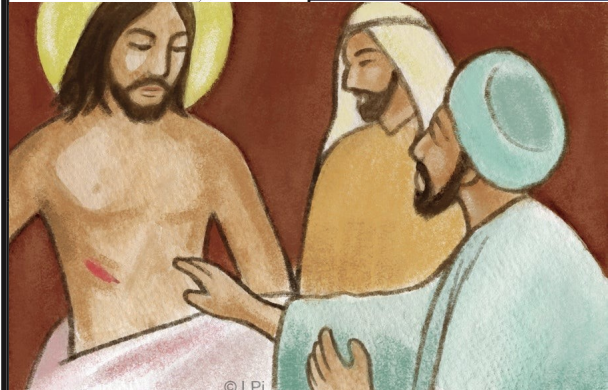
