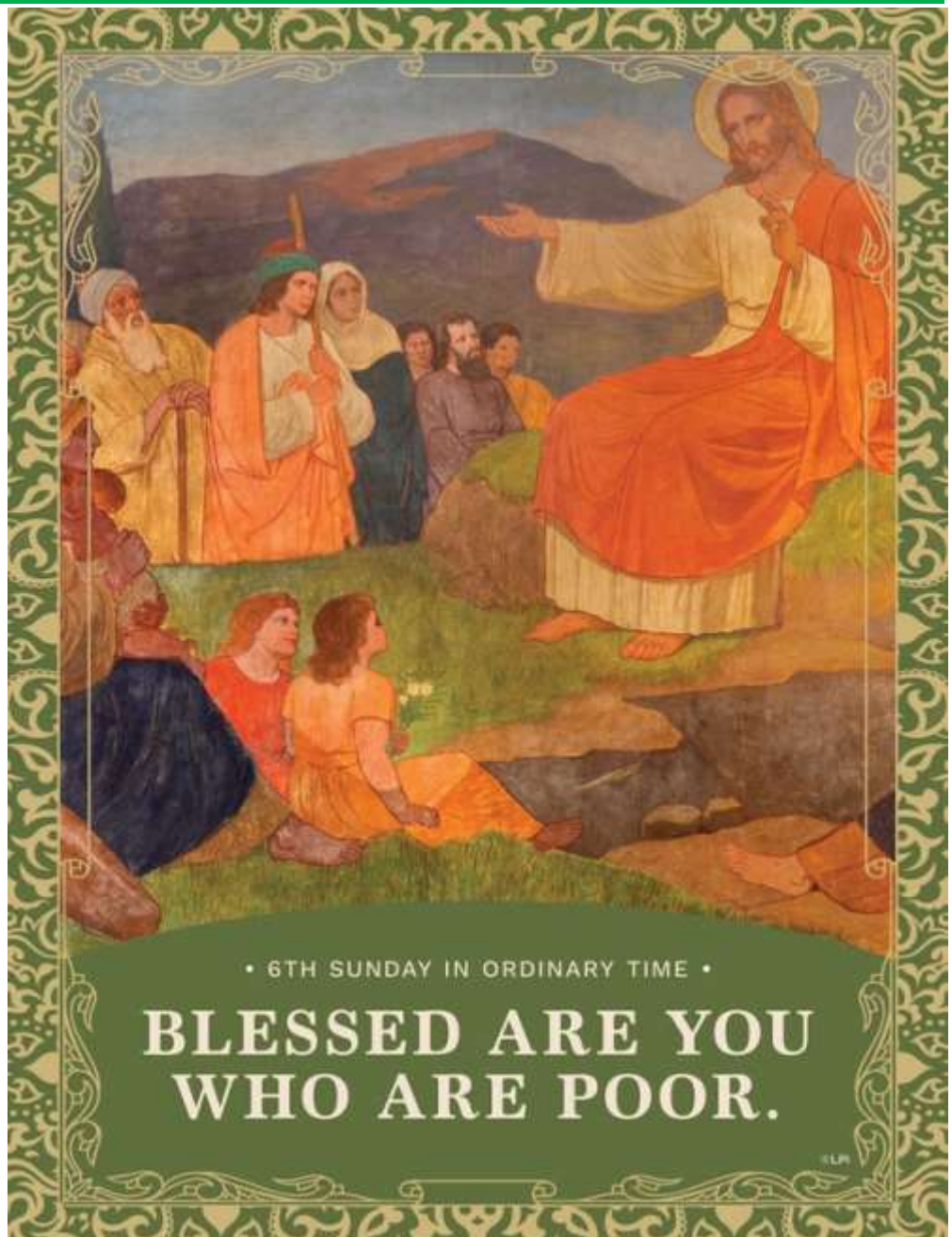

We also helped with housing assistance, clothing and transportation. We meet the 1st Monday of every month at 6:30 pm and we would like to welcome new members. Ordinary people can do great things.


#### Raise the Roof – Holy Rosary School

It has recently come to our attention that the current school roof was improperly installed. Unfortunately, this is causing the roof to leak in multiple places and is damaging the interior of the building.


Consultants have inspected the damage and have provided recommendations to ensure a solution that is long-lasting. Several estimates have been obtained and reviewed by the finance and parish councils. After much discussion, a consensus was reached to remove the failed roof system and properly replace it.

We are looking to you, our parishioners and former Holy Rosary Catholic School families, to help fund this necessary project. The cost to complete the project is \$130,000. We have already received donations in the amount of \$90,000. We are reaching out to you to contribute towards the balance of \$40,000.
