

Several estimates have been obtained and reviewed by the finance and parish councils. After much discussion, a consensus was reached to remove the failed roof system and properly replace it.

We are looking to you, our parishioners and former Holy Rosary Catholic School families, to help fund this necessary project. The cost to complete the project is \$130,000. We have already received donations in the amount of \$90,000. We are reaching out to you to contribute towards the balance of \$40,000.
