# *St. Ann Parish 2021 Stewardship Form*

## **Liturgy & Worship**

**Altar Server** - 4th grade and older, requires one training session, parental permission. Serve at Sunday Mass, Holy Days, weddings and funerals

**Choir** - Sing at Sunday Mass and Holy Days

**Eucharistic Minister** - 18 years or older, confirmed member. Distribute Communion and cup at Mass. Training session provided

**Eucharistic Minister to Homebound** - Distribute communion to homebound on Sunday

**Funeral Choir** - Sing at funeral Masses

**Funeral Eucharistic Minister** - Distribute Communion at funeral Masses

**Funeral Lector** - Read scripture and petitions at funeral liturgies

**Funeral Server** - Serve at funeral Masses

**Gift Bearer** - Bring up gifts of bread and wine during Mass as family, couple or solo

**Greeters** - (all ages) Welcome people, hand out bulletins, ring bells 1 & 2, five minutes before Mass

**Instrumentalist** - Play a musical instrument at Mass

**Lector** - Reads scripture and petitions at Mass. Attend training session

**Liturgy Committee** - Plans and evaluates our Sunday Mass/Holy Days and special liturgical celebrations. Prayer/Worship Committee meets on regular basis

**Liturgical Environment** - Responsible for liturgical decoration of the church

**Liturgical Setup** - Assist with setup of Mass items

**Sacristan** - Keep sacristy, sanctuary and/or the vestibules in clean condition

**Song leader/cantor** - Leads congregation in song

**Usher** - Help seating, setting up extra chairs when needed, and collections. Put moneybags in safe, open/close windows, help lock doors after Mass

## **Education & Spiritual Environment**

**Christmas Eve Mass** - Coordinate the children's program for Christmas Eve Mass.

**Faith Formation Catechist** - Teach youth at Faith Formation classes held on Wednesday nights.

Training required through the program

**Substitute Catechist** - Fill in for catechists at various grade levels.

**RCIA Sponsor** - Assist someone who is joining the Church by offering support and a willingness to share your faith with the candidate

**Youth Choir** - Work with youth in preparation for Youth Masses, Holy Days, or special events.

**Youth Event Planner** - Plan liturgies, outings, and special events for youth of the parish.

## **Service & Committees**

**Bake Sale Group** - Organize and/or help with bake sale at Fall & Spring Dinners

**Buildings & Grounds Committee** - Help with upkeep of buildings, painting, and general repairs

**Bulletin Help** - Place inserts in bulletins, pick up and/or deliver bulletins for Sunday

**Care of flowers/plants** - Plant and care for flowers and planters around church and parish center grounds, water and care for plants in church

**Cemetery Committee** - Works with pastor & trustees in determining needs of cemetery upkeep

**Church Cleaning** - Clean the inside of church and downstairs hall (usually once or twice per year)

**Christmas Cookie Plates** - Organize event and/or help prepare cookie plates for elderly and widows at Christmas time

**Clean Altar Linens** - Take linens home and wash, iron and return to church

**Clean Altar Server robes and vestments** - Clean, mend and iron robes and vestments as needed

**Counter** - Work with another volunteer to count and record stewardship envelopes, offertory, special collections, & other income for deposit

**Dinner Volunteers** - Organize and/or help with fall dinner and spring breakfast, setting up, peeling vegetables, cooking, serving and clean up

**Finance Committee** - Appointed position, responsible for the financial matters of the parish

**Fund Raising Events** - Plan fund raising events

**Funeral Lunch** - Order food, help setting up, cooking, serving and clean up

**Grounds Cleaning** - Help with yard work, raking, and snow shoveling

**Pastoral (Parish) Council** - Works as a consultative group along with pastor regarding parish matters, attend regular monthly meetings and workshops.

**Prayer Ministry** - Commit to daily prayer for the intentions of those on the "Friends in Prayer" line

**Raffles** - Organize fall or spring raffle sale

**Scrip Volunteer** - Sell Scrip before & after Mass

**Sell Raffle Tickets** - Responsible for collecting monies, oversee drawing and notifying winners

**Sell Dinner Tickets** - Responsible for collecting monies for fall and/or spring dinner

**Special Raffle** - Organize and/or help with fall or spring special raffle, collect prizes, hold drawing and notify winners

**Transportation** - Assist elderly and those who need rides to and from Church or other trips

**Trustee** - Elected position, part of parish council, cemetery and finance committees

**Visit Homebound** - Visit any homebound members. Can be extended to hospital visits

**Wedding Help** - Unlock doors, turn on lights, heat, windows, etc. Lock up after wedding.

**Welcome Committee** - Welcome new people to community or church
