Communion Under Both Kinds

A frequent question heard is when will the distribution of the Precious Blood again be offered to the lay faithful. The bishop, not the priest, has the authority to offer the Precious Blood, so we have been waiting on Bishop Ricken to make his determination. Recently, Bishop issued his guidelines for distributing the Precious Blood to the lay faithful in a three-page document that reviews the history and theology of distributing the Precious Blood. For the sake of space, the whole document will not be printed in the bulletin, but a link is provided below. The bishop has allowed the Precious Blood to be distributed on the Sunday of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (Corpus Christi). We will be offering the Precious Blood at all parish Masses that weekend. In addition, the Bishop will allow the distribution of Holy Communion under both kinds at the following liturgical celebrations:

Corpus Christi Sunday (all Masses)
Christ the King Sunday (all Masses)
Christmas Mass (only at the Mass “during the night”)
Holy Thursday Easter (only at the Vigil)
Divine Mercy Sunday (all Masses)
Pentecost Sunday (all Masses)
Trinity Sunday (all Masses)
First Holy Communion (only the first communicants)
Wedding Masses (only the bride and groom)
Mass celebrating the patronal feast of the parish
Mass on the anniversary of the dedication of the church

UPDATED STIPEND & STOLE FEE STRUCTURE

Effective July 1, 2024 New stipend structure is as follows:

Mass Stipend \$20 and Sanctuary Candle \$20

Funeral Stole fee \$75

Wedding & Quinceanera Stole fee \$100

This new fee structure will not be applied retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount from the former fee scale. The new fee structure will be applied to all new requests received as of July 1, 2024 when we will start accepting mass & candles requests for 2025.

Please know, too, that any stipend money collected goes to the parish in support of its ministry and services provided to the parish community; it does not go personally to the priest.

Eucharistic Revival

The Church in the United States is observing a year of Eucharistic Revival, which is a moment to emphasize and celebrate our faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. In this light, the celebration of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) to be observed this year on June 2, takes on an added significance. It is traditional and customary in many Catholic countries to engage in Eucharistic Processions in celebration of the Solemnity.

Here in our three-linked parishes, the challenges of geographical distance do not allow us to physically carry out a walking Eucharistic Procession that will involve our three parish communities. This celebration, however, will not go unobserved in our parishes. Hence, we shall have a Eucharistic Motorcade instead after the 10am Mass at Holy Rosary Church on June 2nd, 2024. Parishioners from our three linked parishes are welcome to Holy Rosary for the beginning of the motorcade.

From Holy Rosary Church, the motorcade will proceed to St. Ann's Church for a brief stop and Adoration.

From there, it will proceed to SS. Peter and Paul, Kiel where it will conclude with a Benediction and Praying of the Divine Praises.

National Eucharistic Pilgrimage

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will pass through the

Diocese of Green Bay on its way to Indianapolis for the National Eucharistic Congress in July.

SS Peter and Paul will celebrate a special Mass with Bishop David Ricken and Archbishop Jerome Listekski of the Milwaukee Archdiocese on Tuesday June 18, 2024 at 5 pm. At that mass the Eucharistic Pilgrimage Monstrance will be handed over to the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. All are invited to attend.

We are planning a meal after Mass. What a great joy to host both Bishops that day! More details will be shared as the day gets closer.



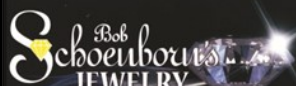
