

Deacon's Perspective

We're at the Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time; well on our way to Lent, which is fast approaching; about three weeks away. A question that I was asked, and I reflect on often, might be good for all of us to consider, goes like this: "Are you able to say with confidence that you are a better person today than you were a year ago?" In other words, how's your spiritual life; has it grown or has stayed the same as last year? Are you a better person today than you were last year? It's a good way to measure our spiritual growth, or lack of growth. This could mean that we are stuck in the spiritual life and I assure you, God wants each of us moving closer to Him every day.

Why do I bring this up? Ash Wednesday is February 18, and thus begins our Lenten journey for 40 days, and are we preparing for this journey? Is it just another Liturgical season we enter into, and come out of, without thinking too much more about.

Our readings this weekend indirectly help us, if we are willing to consider as we move closer to Lent. For example, the second reading from Paul's Letter to the Corinthians. The opening salvo for example: "Consider your calling, brothers and sisters." What calling you may ask; how about your baptism, is that not a calling and entry into the family of God? Are we living the life that we were called to?

There's more, so, let's keep it short. Look at verse 30, and you'll read: "It is due to Him that you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom, as well as righteousness, sanctification, and redemption . . ." What's 'sanctification'? What does it mean? Here's what I found: "It's the process of being made holy and set apart for God's purpose, transforming a believer to become more like Jesus Christ through the power

of the Holy Spirit." In a word, it's called holiness! Jesus said: "be holy, for I am holy". So, maybe conforming our life to the likeness of Christ is another way to understand 'sanctification'.

I like stories, and perhaps this story can help.

A man was nailing down a loose shingle on his roof when he lost his footing and began to slip. Working three stories above ground, he was terrified at the thought of falling to his death. He shouted, "God, help me! I'm falling! Do something!" Just as he came to the edge of the roof, his belt loop caught on a nail and stopped him long enough for him to grab hold of the roof and pull himself to safety.

He shouted, "Never mind, God! The nail stopped my fall."

How many times have we been guilty of the same kind of obliviousness in our own prayers? We cry out to God in a moment of distress. He answers our cry by working through the situation to relieve our distress. Then we say, "Never mind, God! Everything worked out by itself."

Maybe a better solution is to examine our circumstances to see where God intervened so that we can give Him the praise and gratitude He deserves. "Holiness!?"

We can't always see the work He does, but we can be certain that when things work together for the good, it's because God orchestrated it. So, we need to put as much zeal into thanking God for what He's done as we put into pleading with God when we're in need.

May we become holy and sanctify our lives, as Christ is asking of us.


Mission Quilters
