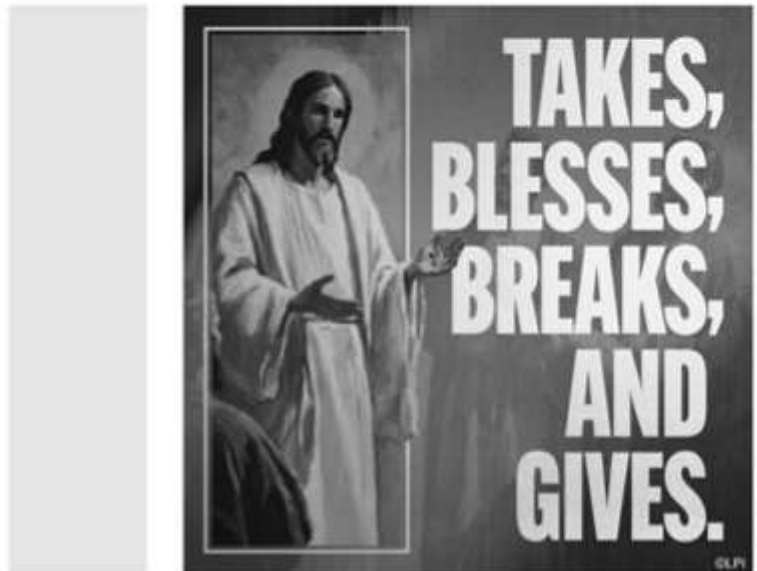

## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

A Catholic friend of mine occasionally says, "The Eucharist is not a noun. It's a verb." In so saying, he is making the point that the Eucharist isn't simply Jesus' bodily presence given to us in holy Communion. It also manifests the dynamic pattern by which Christ actively loves and saves us. He teaches us to cooperate with that pattern. This Eucharist actually embodies four verbs: Jesus takes, blesses, breaks, and gives. Let's consider each one.

He **takes**: Do we acknowledge that we are totally in God's hands? Do we receive everything in our lives as a gift, and act responsibly with it?

He **blesses**: Do we actively reflect that Jesus makes us holy in our baptism? Do we embrace our bodies and souls as temples of God, worthy of love, peace, and joy?

He **breaks**: Do we run from failure and disappointment, from getting old or being ignored? Are we too worried about getting hurt or sick? Do we embrace our sufferings with confidence?

He **gives**: Are we willing to make our lives a gift for others? Are we confident that we will always have enough love to give to others, that God will always provide enough for us? Do we rejoice in giving away what we have to others, expecting nothing in return? This is the dynamic life the Eucharist empowers us to live.

### **Corpus Christi Procession**

This Sunday join us for the Corpus Christ procession immediately following the 10 am Mass at Holy Rosary as we celebrate the Eucharist as the body of Christ. The solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ, historically known by its Latin name, Corpus Christi, celebrates the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist – Body, Soul, and Divinity.

We give thanks to God for his “yes” and that He sustain him always in his priestly ministry. We also ask that as part of this Holy Hour, we pray for those whom the Lord may be calling to the priesthood and religious life from their respective parish – that they may also hear the call and say “yes”.

### **Most Sacred Heart of Jesus Prayer Service**

Thursday, June 26 Holy Rosary will host a prayer service for the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus at 1 PM. The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is a Catholic devotion that views the heart of Jesus Christ as a symbol of God’s boundless and passionate love for mankind. It represents Christ’s love for humanity and emphasizes his divine and human compassion. Deacon Dennis Bennin will preside at the service.

### **Adoration/Exposition of the Eucharist**

We drive by our parish Eucharistic Adoration, thinking we should stop in, but we just don’t have time. But what if we slowed down and stopped in? What if we made the simple practice of our weekly Eucharistic Adoration just for 15 minutes with no “props”—no books, rosaries, set prayers or routines—just us and Jesus for the summer? It would slow us down. It would give us depth. It would help us see Jesus in the midst of everywhere else in our life, both in that church and outside of it. Spend some time with Jesus. From 4—5 pm on Mondays (SS. Peter & Paul) Wednesdays (Holy Rosary) and Fridays (St. Ann) our churches will be open for you to come, sit in silence and spend time with Jesus. All are invited and welcome.
