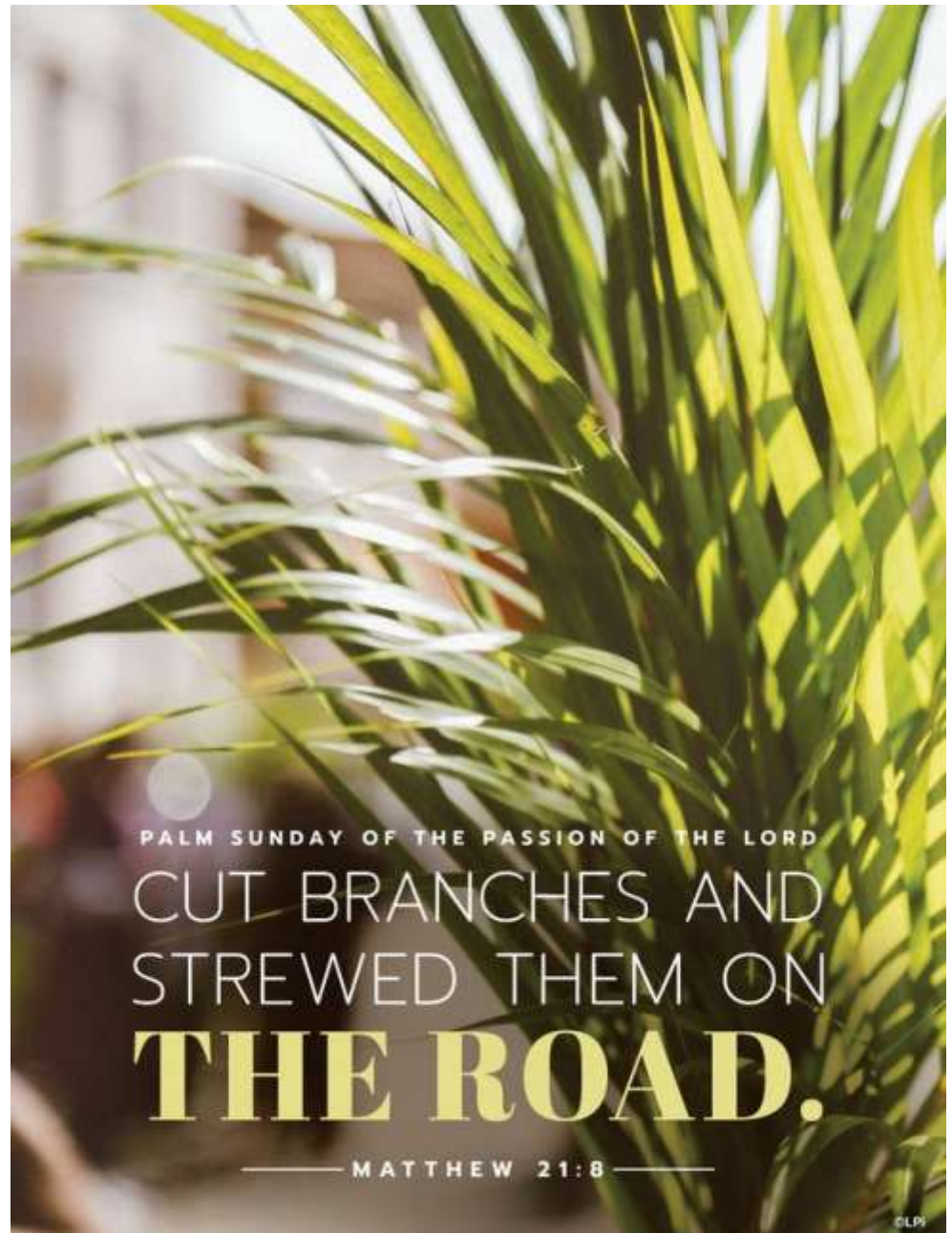

Our Religious Education year is winding down. I feel fortunate to have met so many welcoming and supportive families and am grateful for the gracious volunteers who stepped up in support of the program. We have been offering more interactive activities in large groups to keep the children in 5K - 6th grade engaged, more importantly we are getting them out of their desks. In mid-February, this group tucked away the Alleluia.

The Wednesday following Easter we will recover the Joyful Alleluia with a small celebration.



We had a successful Family Lent Event on February 11th. The turnout from our three linked parishes was remarkable. These events typically include moms and kids along with dads but the many dads in attendance at this particular event was wonderful, truly inspirational to see so many dads leading by example. The parents and their children reviewed information on Lent and then as a family they participated in eight Interactive Prayer Stations. The evening concluded with a family take home project reminding them to stay prayerful during Lent.



We currently have twenty-two students preparing to receive First Eucharist and 14 students preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation. You are invited to participate in the Paschal Mystery, the saving life, suffering, passion, death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Holy Thursday is when Jesus invites us to keep watch with him as he enters into his passion.

6 PM Thursday 4/2/26 – St. Ann, St. Anna

Good Friday is the solemn commemoration of the crucifixion and death of Jesus Christ on the Friday before Easter.

1 PM Friday 4/3/26 – Holy Rosary, New Holstein

Easter Vigil is the final, silent day of the Easter Triduum, marking the time Jesus' body lay in the tomb after his crucifixion and his soul descended to the dead.

8 PM Saturday 4/4/26 – Ss. Peter & Paul, Kiel

Easter Sunday celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead three days after his crucifixion.

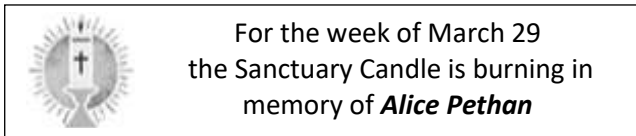

So we're shouting it out loud! **THANK YOU!** We served 222 fish plates during the lunch hour, we delivered another 431 to area businesses, and another 343 were served at night, for a total of 996. We did run out of fish early, and we apologize to anyone we had to turn away. We already made adjustments in our notes to be sure we don't run out again. Our goal is to serve everyone. We made just over \$10,000 profit, and that helped us pay the school subsidy in March.

175th Anniversary of St. Ann Parish

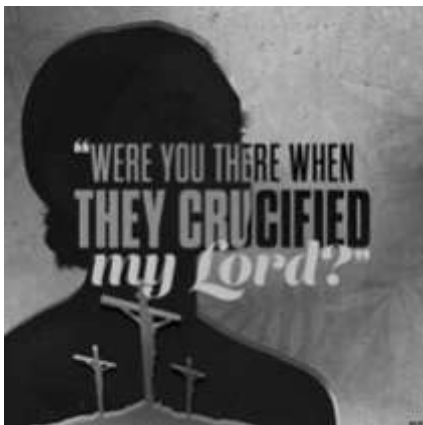

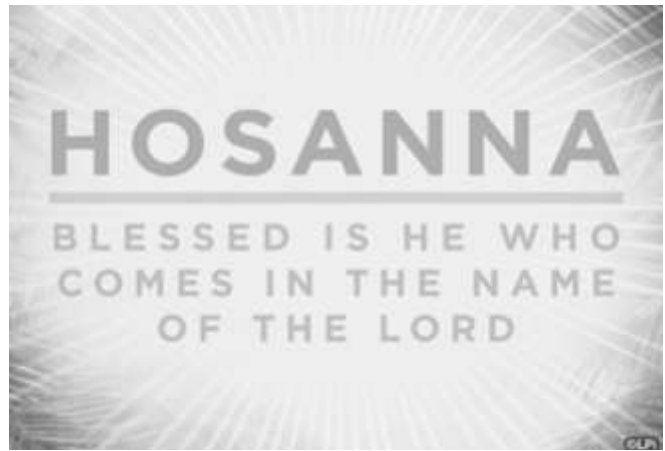
