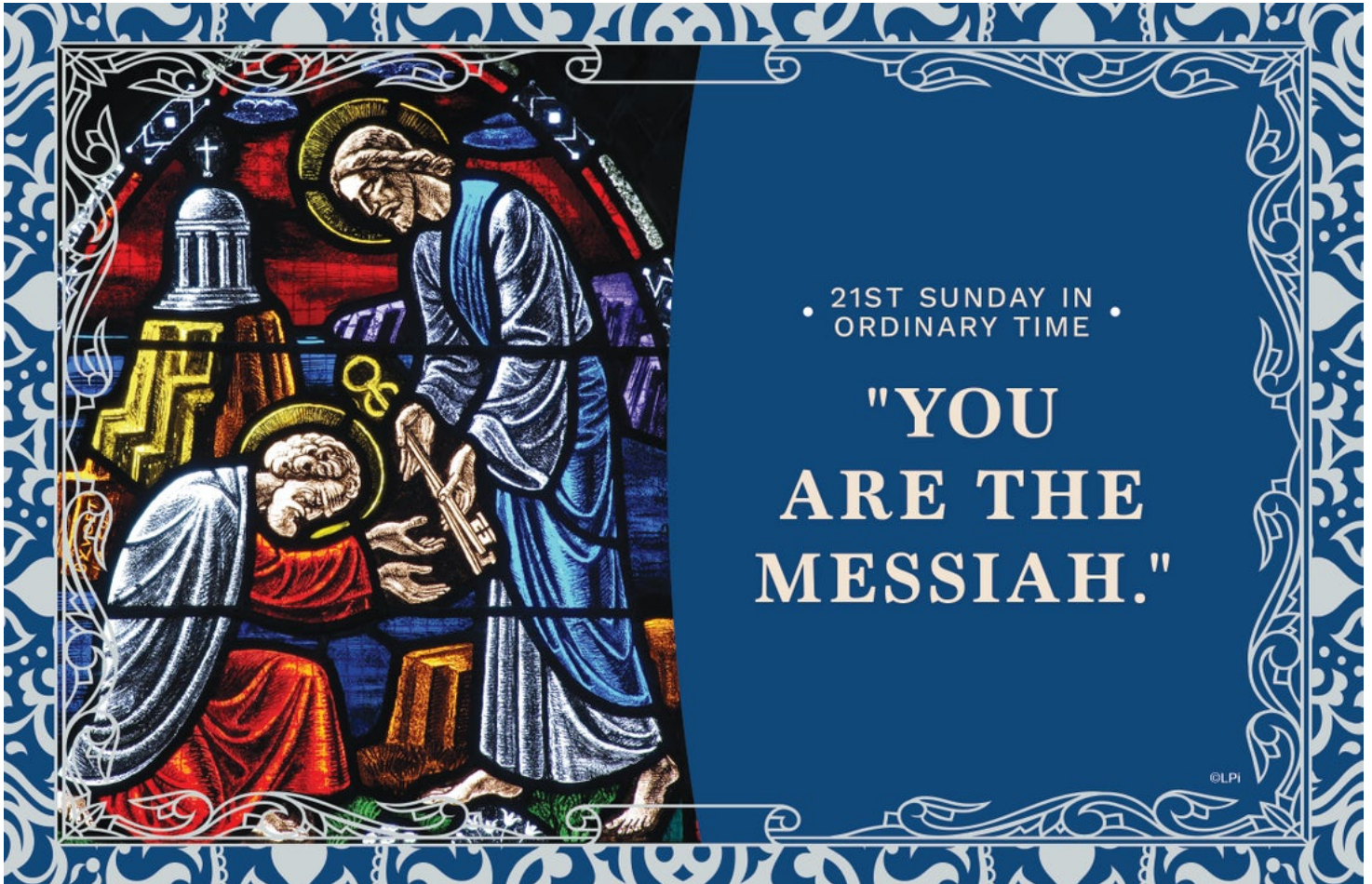

## words on the WORD

### ***In Memoriam: Fr. August "Gus" Belauskas***

Earlier this month, one of my eminent seminary professors, Fr. August Belauskas, was laid to rest. Ordained in 1968, Fr. "Gus" as we all called him, was a priest of the Archdiocese of Chicago and a veteran seminary formator. He was 83 years old at his passing and had spent nearly 40 years on the Faculty of Mundelein Seminary where he served as Formation Advisor, Vice Rector, Cam Priest and Spiritual Director.

Fr. Gus was a kind, thoughtful, unassuming and gentle shepherd to the seminarians placed under his care. I was one of those seminarians. Who would ever forget his calming and reassuring voice to a nervous and flustered first year seminarian learning to lead at community prayers? In his deep baritone, he would solemnly intone: "relax, you're not getting ordained tomorrow."

I would never forget his goodness and graciousness to me when I was assigned as a transitional deacon to St. Gilbert Parish Grayslake Illinois for my weekend diaconal assignment, a parish in the suburbs of Mundelein where Fr. Gus helped out as a weekend assistant priest for decades. His feedback on the few occasions I was assigned to preach was nothing but encouraging, kind and wise. I will forever treasure the conversations we had as he drove me to St. Gilbert Parish on Sunday mornings and brought me back to campus later in the afternoon. When my father passed away weeks after my priestly ordination in 2013, Fr. Gus reached out to me even though I had graduated from the seminary.

Last weekend, we had a seminarian visit our parishes to speak about his vocation. As we take up the Raising Vocations collections during this time, I wanted to highlight the enduring witness and priestly life of Fr. Gus Belauskas who inspired me as a seminarian. I learned so much from him. His life was truly impactful, and his priestly ministry was profoundly fruitful. A good and faithful servant, may he now enter into his Master's joy. Requiescat in Pace.

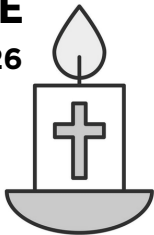

Heartfelt thanks to all who helped make our SS Peter and Paul pie stand a huge success. To our volunteers who helped serve in the pie stand, thank you. To those who provided a torte or pies--and extras on Sunday--and those who cut and packaged them, thank you. To our amazing set up and take down crew, thank you. To our fabulous pie stand committee, who went above and beyond so we could continue this annual tradition that started 34 years ago, thank you. And thank you to the people who stopped by our new location to say hi or grab a piece of dessert...we especially thank you for supporting us. Year after year after year. We sold 65 dirt cups, 200 ice cream cookie sandwiches, 178 pies, 122 tortes and 11 brownies/cakes. We went through 92 gallons of ice cream and 775 cones and 530 cups of ice cream. We received \$600 towards the purchase of a new cooler, which was \$2,500. We made \$10,600 this year. There are empty pans in the church basement. Please stop down after Mass on the weekend to pick them up.

and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." (Mt 16:19)

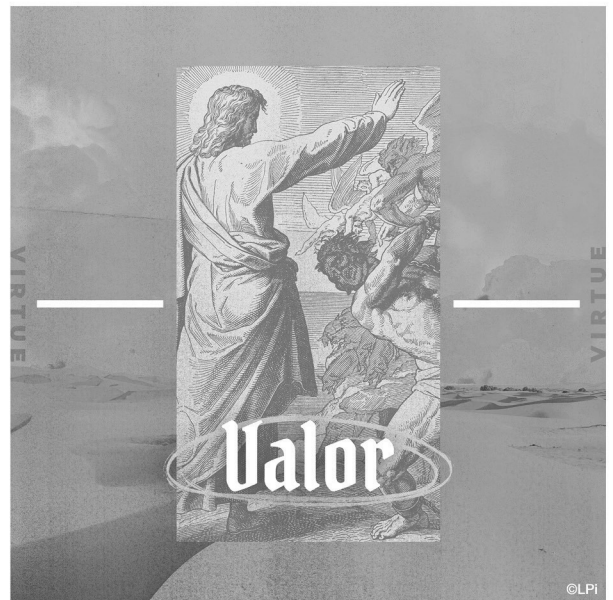

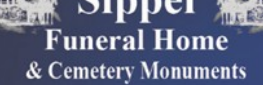
## Virtues, *Explained!*
