It's the Third Sunday of Advent and I wonder, how is your Advent Season so far? The Christmas Season is nearly here, and Advent gives us the opportunity to consider fully what Christmas truly means. Being that this is the Third Sunday of Advent which is called "Gaudete Sunday", which many of you know is Latin for 'Rejoice'. Are you joyful and in anticipation of the Christ Child, or has the challenging hunt (shopping spree) occupying our time and attention; looking for that perfect gift. The Christmas season always seems to provide us with ample room and time distraction, to sway our attention, away from that where God is calling us.

I believe that music allows us pray twice with song, and is one of the many ways we can be drawn into the life and love of Jesus Christ. There is one hymn in particular for me I think is really beautiful by John Michael Talbot in which he sings, and it moves my soul called "The Magnificat". It's the same hymn, but a different melody we hear in our Responsorial Psalm this weekend. Another name for this song is "The Prayer of Mary". Have you heard of it, or do you know this prayer or this beautiful hymn?

There are a couple of lines that are exceedingly beautiful and especially poignant in which the Blessed Mother says: "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior." Another is "and Holy is His Name." Do we grasp fully what Our Blessed Mother is expressing?

I've mentioned in previous articles how I'm reading and studying the writings from Luisa Piccarreta and the Book of Heaven, and the messages she received from our Lord and our Blessed Mother. The following message comes from volume 10 in which Jesus told her, and really all of us: "In the world I need mirrors to which to go and look at Myself. Only then can a fount serve as a mirror in which people can reflect themselves".

I asked earlier how is your Advent

journey going; I pray it is going well, but you may consider reflecting on 'The Prayer of Mary" (the Magnificat), so that you too can say, my soul proclaims the greatness of the 'Lord'.

Let us pray the "Prayer of Mary" this Advent and beyond, to better reflect, and be the mirror of Christ, so as to reflect back, the greatness of the Lord.

The Prayer Of Mary
My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord,
my spirit rejoices in God my Savior
for he has looked with favor on his lowly
servant.

From this day all generations will call me blessed: the Almighty has done great things for me, and holy is his Name.

He has mercy on those who fear him in every generation.

He has shown the strength of his arm, he has scattered the proud in their conceit. He has cast down the mighty from their thrones, and has lifted up the lowly.

He has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich he has sent away empty. He has come to the help of his servant Israel for he remembered his promise of mercy, the promise he made to our fathers, to Abraham and his children forever.

(Lk 1: 46-55)



Mass Obligations

In 2023 Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday. And like all Sundays, Catholics are required to attend Mass in person, unless there is some legitimate reason (like illness or inclement weather) that makes attending Mass unduly difficult or impossible.

Of course the following Monday, December 25, is Christmas Day, which is also a holy day of obligation. Because there are two days of obligation — Sunday and Christmas — this means that there are two distinct obligations to speak of. Each separate obligation needs to be fulfilled by attending a separate Mass. That is, you cannot "double dip" by attending a Christmas Eve Mass that happens to be on Sunday and having this one Mass fulfill two obligations.

For the weekend's obligation, people can attend the 4:00 pm Mass at SSPP, the 8:00 am Mass at SA or the 10:00 am Mass at HR. The 8:00 pm Mass would not count as the weekend's obligation, as that is considered Christmas Eve. So, Christmas Eve would be the 4:00 pm Mass at SA, the 6:00 pm Mass at HR and 8:00 pm Mass at SSPP. Christmas Day is the 8:00 am Mass at SA and SSPP, and 10:00 am Mass at HR.

If you attend a vigil Mass on Saturday Dec 23, and then the Christmas vigil Mass on Sunday Dec 24 (Christmas Eve) for Christmas day, then you've got it all covered.
