Live The Liturgy Inspiration of the Week

In the desert, Jesus endured forty days of hardship and temptation. But he did not endure it alone: “the angels ministered to him,” the Gospel tells us. Remember that you do not face Lent alone. God is beside you in your journey to the desert.



Lent

Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday until they cele-

brate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may only eat one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted, if necessary, to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Fasting during Lent helps us detach from worldly comforts and desires, allowing us to hunger for a deeper relationship with God.

Almsgiving reminds us of our responsibility to care for those in need, fostering a spirit of generosity and compassion. All second collections during Lent will benefit our Lenten Project Faith on Fire, support for Maui, Hawaii. And through prayer, we communicate with God, seeking forgiveness, grace, and a deeper love. Feel free to take one of the daily reflection prayer booklets located at entryways to assist you in prayer during this Lenten season.

Welcome Dcn Mark Rydell

Dcn Mark Rydell, who is a seminarian of the Green Bay Diocese in the last year of seminary formation, has been assigned to our parish for his weekend diaconal assignment beginning this first Sunday of Lent. Dcn Mark is a transitional Deacon (which is different from a permanent Deacon) because he is in formation for the Priesthood. God willing, his priestly ordination will take place in the Spring this year. His seminary formation takes place at St. Francis de Sales Seminary in Milwaukee. As he is not done with seminary classes yet, he can only be with us 2 or 3 weekends each month beginning from the first weekend of Lent, February 17/18, 2024. He will also assist with the Holy week liturgies. Let us welcome him to our parish communities, support him with our prayers and provide helpful feedback to him as he continues to grow in his formation for the priesthood of Christ.

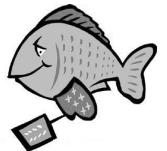

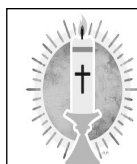
