Altar Server - 4th grade and older, training session, parental permission.

Art & Environment - Responsible for liturgical decoration of the church

Buildings & Grounds Committee- assist with occasional building repair and grounds keeping projects.

Care of plants - Plant and care for flowers and planters around church grounds, water and care for plants in church

Catholic Order of Foresters - A Catholic life insurance company supporting our Catholic community through fraternal outreach of spiritual, social and community service projects and helping members achieve financial security.

Cemetery Help – Cut lawn & trim weeds

Children's Liturgy of the Word -During the Sunday morning Mass you lead the children proclaiming the Scripture readings and do activities pertaining to the gospel story. Great for families! Training provided.

Choir - Sing at Sunday Mass and Holy Days

Christmas Eve Mass – Coordinate the children's program for Christmas Eve Mass.

Clean Altar Linens - Take linens home and wash, iron and return to church

Clean Altar Server robes and vestments - Clean, mend and iron robes and vestments as needed

Country Breakfast - held two or three times a year from 8 am till Noon in Voland Hall.

Eucharistic Minister - 18 years or older, confirmed member. Distribute Communion and cup at Mass. Training session provided

Faith Formation Catechist - Teach youth at Faith Formation classes held on Wednesday nights. Training required through the program

Fish Fry - Help is needed to work; set up, prep, during the dinner and clean up, always the first Friday of March

Funeral Choir - Sing at funeral Masses

Funeral Lunch - Order food, help setting up, cooking, serving and clean up

Funeral Server –Serve at funeral Masses

Greeters - (all ages) Open doors and welcome people ten minutes before Mass

Holy Dusters - Clean the inside of church (2nd & 4th Thursdays at 8 am)

Homebound - Visiting parishioners unable to attend Mass bringing Christ to them through prayer and communion

Instrumentalist - Play a musical instrument at Mass

Knights of Columbus - A fraternal benefit society dedicated to providing charitable services, promoting Catholic education and actively defending Catholicism.

Pie Stand – During the Kiel Community Picnic, help is needed each day & night in varying shifts, all parishioners make pies/tortes

Prayer & Worship Committee - Plans and evaluates our Masses/Holy Days and special liturgical celebrations. Committee meets on regular basis

Pastoral (Parish) Council - Works as a consultative group along with pastor

regarding parish matters, attend regular monthly meetings and workshops.

Proclaimer of the Word (Lector) - Reads scripture and petitions at Mass. Attend training session

Prayer Ministry - Commit to daily prayer for the intentions of those on the "Prayer line"

Sacristan - Assist with setup of Mass items. Keep sacristy, sanctuary clean

Scrip Volunteer – Sell Scrip after weekend Mass and/or counts inventory & sales on Monday mornings in the rectory

Song leader/cantor - Leads congregation in song

Substitute Catechist – Fill in for catechists at various grade levels.

Sunday Social - A fun way for families or groups to coordinate weekly “coffee and donut” parish fellowship after Sunday Mass

St Vincent de Paul Society- organization of lay persons seeks, in a spirit of justice and charity, to help those in need.

St. Vincent de Paul Store - Volunteers assist the store with merchandise, displays and organizing.

Usher- Help seating, setting up extra chairs when needed, and collections. Put moneybags in safe, open/close windows, help lock doors after Mass

Youth Event Planner - Plan liturgies, outings, and special events for youth of the parish.
