POLICIES

ABSENTEEISM

If a student is unable to attend classes due to sickness or another valid reason, please call your catechist. Attendance is the responsibility of parents. Therefore, the Faith Formation program as a courtesy, MAY call parents but it is not a basic responsibility to do so.

ATTENDANCE

All students of SS. Peter and Paul Parishes in kindergarten through grade twelve, who attend local public schools, are expected to participate in the Faith Formation Program.

CELL PHONES

Cell phones are not allowed to be used during class time, unless permission is given by the catechist.

CLASS CANCELLATION

When the public school is closed or closes early, Faith Formation classes for the students are canceled. If bad weather conditions develop after school hours, an email will be sent to all families regarding cancellation.

COMMUNICATION

A weekly email reminder will be sent out on Tuesday each week of the year. If there are changes or additions to the schedule they will be included in the weekly email. If your family does not have access to email please inform Danielle so she can communicate through other means.

DISRUPTIVE STUDENTS

Students will be given one verbal warning in class. The second time they are disciplined, they will be sent to study hall for the remainder of the class. Parents will be required to pick their child up from the study hall room and sign a form acknowledging the student's behavior. This form will need to be signed before the student may return to class the following week. If a student is sent to study hall two times, a meeting will be held between the parents and the Faith Formation coordinator to determine the necessary next steps for the student to be allowed to return to class

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The facilities that we use for classes each have their own procedures for emergencies, such as fire, tornado and intruder. These are taught to the catechists who will inform the students of the proper plan.

Homeschooling

Families who chose to homeschool grades K-8 will be asked to complete 8 chapters in the grade level text book the 1st semester and another 8 the 2nd semester. They are required to attend the larger group events and turn in their completed chapters at these events.

Volunteer Credit

Each family is asked to volunteer within the program for one event per year. Families who do not meet the volunteer requirement will be charged an additional \$25 tuition fee for the 2024-2025 school year.
